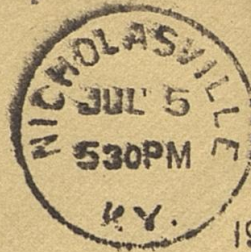

good now

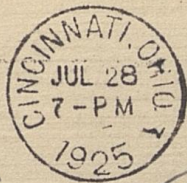
We four had more fun Sun
