In Kentucky, 97% of electricity generated by burning coal (52% nationally). Kentucky has lowest electricity cost in nation at 4.1 cents per kilowatt hour. Major attraction to electrically intensive industries, chemical and metallurgy. State is major aluminum refiner/fabricator, U-235. West Lake at Calvert City uses \$2 million in electricity per month.
