TO BUILD THE TOWN AND MINE SUPPORT FACILITIES BIG LOONEY CREEK WAS ROUTED AND OVER ONE MILE WAS WALLED WITH LOCALLY QUARRIED WATER SANDSTONE. IN ADDITION TO THE STRUCTURES CHRONICLED HERE THE COAL COMPANY CONSTRUCTED SIX MILES OF CONCRETE PAVED STREETS, FIFTY MILES OF WATCH LINES, POWER LINES, ONE OF THE LARGEST COMPANY STORES IN THE WORLD, A HOSPITAL, 50 ROOM HOTEL, BANK, POST OFFICE, ELEMENTARY AND HIGH SCHOOLS, AND 1000 HOMES SERVED BY OUTHOUSES CONNECTED TO A CENTRAL SEWAGE DISPOSAL PLANT. THE CITY HAD OVER 10,000 RESIDENTS AT ONE TIME.



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
