

LIBRARY

The university library embraces the books belonging to the colleges and schools of the university. These consist of the general library, the law library, the experiment station library and various department libraries.

The university library is a government depository and receives all the official publications of the United States Government.

The experiment station library is regarded as a branch of the general library and is administered under the direction of the university librarian. In it are placed depository catalogues of the publications of the United States Department of Agriculture and of the experiment stations of the various states.

There is a total of 57,721 volumes in the university to which you have access.

The general library is open as follows:

Week days (legal holidays excepted),
8:00 a. m. to 9:30 p. m.

Sundays, during regular session, 2:00 to
5:30 p. m.

Vacation periods, 9:00 a. m. to 12:00 m.
daily.

The experiment station library is open
from 8:00 a. m. to 5:00 p. m. daily except
Saturday, when the hours are from 8:00
a. m. to 1:00 p. m.

The old chapel on the second floor of
the Administration Building has been
equipped as a supplementary reading room
and will be used this year for general study
and for all required readings, which are to
be placed on "reserved shelves" behind the
desk.

The hours of opening for this reading-
room will be the same as for the general
library.
