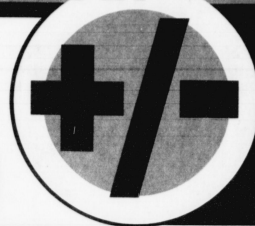

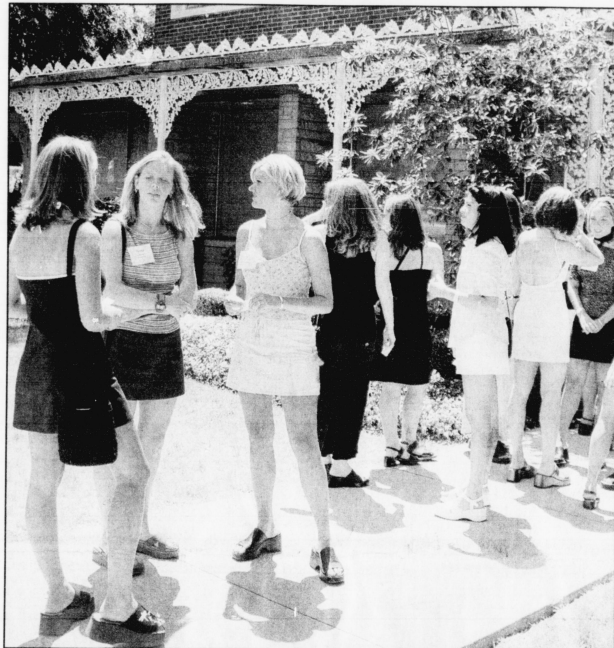

Young women find out Friday who they'll call "sisters" when sorority rush wraps up and prospects become pledges.

The pledges didn't have to endure any *Animal House* tactics. Instead, they performed community service projects and participated in orientation with different sororities.

"Members have been preparing for this all year," said Stephanie Courtright, vice president of recruiting for the UK Pan-Hellenic Council.

The annual school supply drive introduced pledges to the charitable duties of Greek life. School supplies were gathered and donated to Fayette County schools to benefit underprivileged children.

Chapter members reviewed bids for membership

in their social sororities at the end of the week. Using criteria such as grades, leadership qualities and interests and hobbies, members narrowed the lists of applicants. The young women were notified Thursday which sororities would accept them as pledges.

Preference parties held Thursday night provided an opportunity for prospects to decide which sorority they would ultimately pledge.

"For them (prospective members), it's mixed emotions," Courtright said. "Some are upset because they've been released, but the next day they find something they like."

Although pledges traditionally join during rush week, the sororities accept bids throughout the year, depending on the size of their charter.

Delta Zeta will accept pledges for their new UK chapter the week of August 23-27. Female UK students of any academic year may pledge.

But rushing Greek organizations is not over yet. Beginning next week, the men will open the doors of their fraternity houses from 8 p.m. to midnight, inviting prospective pledges to check out what they have to offer.

To begin with: Program helps new students get adjusted to life at UK

UK is trying to make life a little easier for new students getting oriented to campus life. Kentucky Welcome, a series of events and programs designed specifically for new students, runs from today through Tuesday.

"We're trying to build community," said Tammy Howard, assistant director of New Student Programs. "It's important, to retain students, that they feel connected and a part of the UK community."

Freshmen, who start moving into the dorms today at 9 a.m., are staring down the barrel of a week packed with orientation and getting-to-know-you activities.

New students participating in Kentucky Welcome can mingle with their fellow dorm dwellers at ice cream socials, figure out the essentials of finance, learn how to avoid the dreaded "freshman 15" and generally meet and greet other new students.

There are also more serious events, such as college-specific meetings for any of UK's undergraduate colleges.

Here are a few Kernel picks we feel every new stu-

dent should try to attend.
• "The Date", a play about relationships, sex, alcohol and violence with a discussion afterwards. It shows in the Worship Theater (in the Student Center Annex) 3:30 to 4:30 p.m. Saturday and Sunday from 2 to 3 p.m. or 3:30 to 4:30 p.m.

• You Count, Calories Don't Healthy Eating at College. Sure, hitting the KFC in Blazer Hall every night sounds tempting, but that three-piece chicken box is a sure way to pack on the "freshman 15." Learn about healthy eating at college, body image and eating disorders at this program, located in 231 Student Center, Sunday from 3 to 4 p.m.

• Student Center Spectacular: This offers all kinds of odd entertainment, from line dancing to magicians. It's also a good way to get familiar with some of the various student organizations, who will have display tables and group members on hand to answer questions and provide information. This runs Sunday from 8 p.m. to midnight.

• William T. Young Library tours. The new library can be huge, confusing and easy to get lost in. Learn how to find your way through it, Monday 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. or 2 to 3 p.m.

How to use the course listings

UK-VIP allows students to adjust their class schedules from anywhere with a telephone.

To acquaint - or reacquaint - yourself with the system, dial 7-7000 from campus or 257-7000 from off-campus.

Personal Access Code

Enter your social security number and your 4-digit personal access code (PAC). If you are using the system for the first time, your PAC will be based on your birthday - if you were born on August 8, for instance, your PAC would be 0808.

For security reasons, the system requires you to change your birthday-based PAC upon its first use.

Students who forget their PAC after a long semester or crazy summer should go to 10 Funkhouser with a picture ID.

Once you have entered your PAC, UK-VIP will allow you to add or drop classes.

Adding/dropping courses

To ensure you don't drop a class only to find the course you wanted is full, use the option of conditional drop/add. If a specified course is not available, you won't lose the course you already have.

The system refers to classes through their five-digit call numbers, so be sure to have those at hand. They are found in the 1999 Fall Schedule of Classes book.

If a class is closed, your best option is to call the professor to see if there is a possibility of getting in. Often, classes will thin out after the first couple of days of class as students refine their schedules.

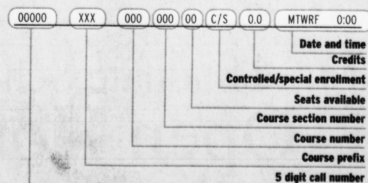
If a particular class has a hold, there may be an eligibility requirement. Consult your adviser to determine whether you can have the hold lifted.

UK-VIP will allow you to add classes until 8 p.m. on August 31.

Check your schedule

Use option number five to avoid the embarrassment of attending a class you thought you'd signed up for, only to find out you don't have a seat.

Users guide: This publication is designed to let students know what classes are available, cancelled or require special enrollment.

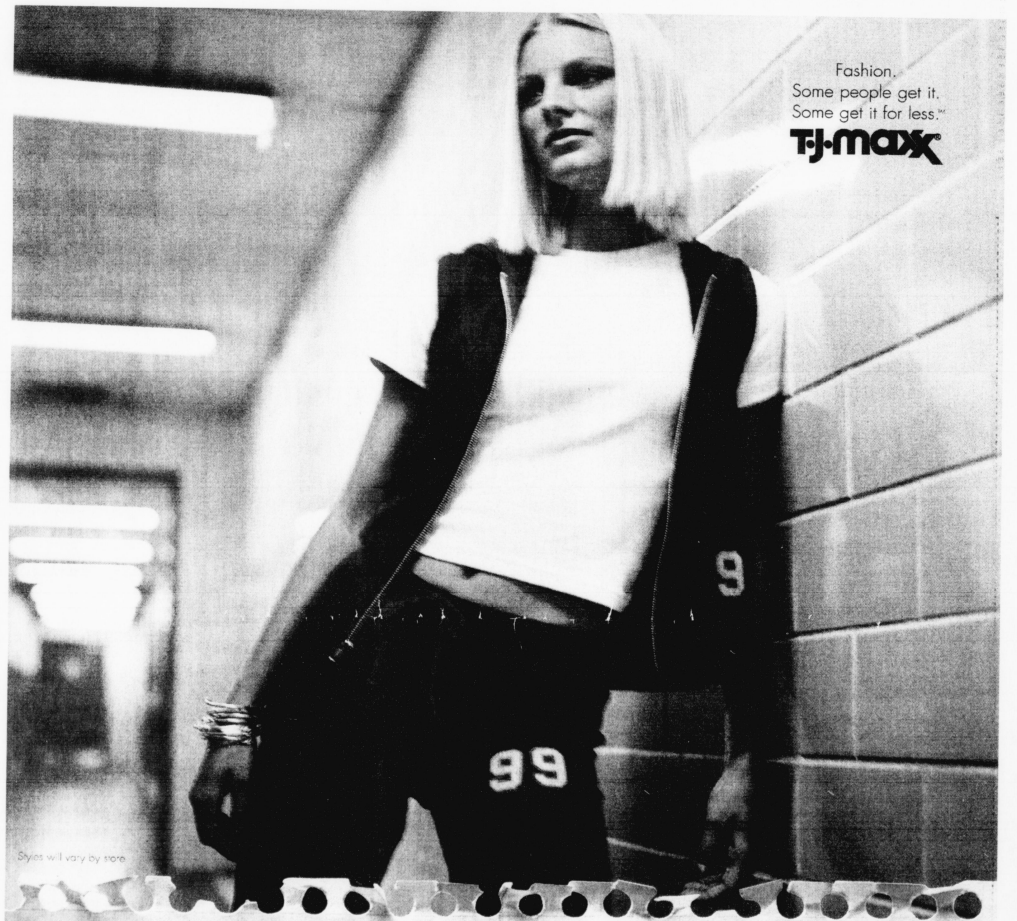

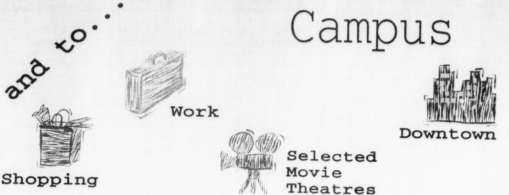

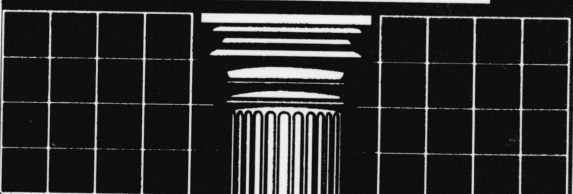

Aiming toward the future

Tackling Success: A new quarterback, a renovated stadium and the same winning attitude for the next UK football season

Let it be said, UK football is on the rise. So much is obvious after taking a look at the 10,000 seats which have been added to Commonwealth Stadium for the 1999 season.

Not that the Cats haven't earned the \$24 million dollar renovation.

After a two-year turnaround from the Port-o-let of college pigskin, UK coach Hal Mumme has turned fans' memories of the Bill Curry era and one-win records to last season's 7-5 record and Outback Bowl campaign.

Keeping the Big Blue faithful away from a major case of college déjà vu may be his toughest task now.

With the loss of Tim Couch, Craig Yeast and the whole offensive line, UK faces a Southeastern Conference schedule that includes five opponents ranked in the top 25. Some preseason polls have nine of UK's 11 foes ranked ahead of them.

Lucky for the Cats their coach hasn't paid much attention.

"We want to win the SEC," Mumme said. "Everyone is even right now."

Mumme's strong suit will be his experienced defense and highly touted recruiting class, which includes the likes of Bob-

by Blizzard and Derek Smith, two tight ends who both stand over 6-5.

And while most of the offense has disappeared, a talented chunk of it returns with backs Derek Homer and Anthony White, along with wide receiver Quentin McCord.

The final piece of the offensive face-lift is sophomore Dusty Bonner, who'll be filling the quarterback vacancy.

"Dusty can't make the plays physically that Couch could, but he offers more in cerebral capacity," Mumme said. "We hope that will balance out."

Bonner, who beat out Mike Scipione in spring practice, is coming off a redshirt season. His only collegiate experience came during his freshman year when he was backup to the Deuce. In eight games, Bonner completed 11 of 14 passes for 114 yards.

Despite Bonner's thin resume, Mumme is confident in his new ace.

"He is the unquestionable leader of this team," Mumme said.

Freshman Jared Lorenzen, last year's Mr. Football in Kentucky, is more than likely going to redshirt, Mumme said.

UK will face Louisville for its season opener on Sept. 4 at Commonwealth.

A Big Blue Bash weekend

This Saturday's Big Blue Bash will be hosted — appropriately — by a cat.

104.5 FM, known as "The Cat," hosts this year's festivities, where UK students can meet their fellow students, see more of the campus and participate in a variety of activities from 9 to 11 p.m.

"Studies show that students who are made to feel welcome at their new school are more likely to be successful at that institution," says Tammy Howard, assistant director of New Student Programs. A 'Magic' kind of coffee house

Owner of the latest java cafe to hit campus wants to set his place apart from the others- and he's doing a good job

Keith Hautala, the 28-year-old owner of Magic Beans Coffee House, sits at one of the cafe's large round tables and points to the unfinished work around him.

"The place is sort of sparsely decorated right now," he notes. "It's like a work in progress, with how it looks and feels. We got a lot of the furniture and props from thrift stores here and in Chicago and we'd like to do more."

Despite Hautala's self-deprecating claims that it's sparse, Magic Beans' layout feels comfortable when you walk in. A long, U-shaped, wooden bar dominates the open space along with a tall bookshelf, while several couches and large tables provide customers with comfortable places to sit. The cafe appears minimalist without being too spartan.

"It's kind of engineered for camping and hanging out," said Hautala. "That is cool, I think. I remember when I was going to school we always

needed a place to go between classes to study or meet people, or pretend to study and try to meet people."

Magic Beans is the newest caffeine peddler to open in the campus area, joining Common Grounds on High Street as one of only two places within easy walking distance from Central Campus that cater specifically to the caffeine junkie. Located in South Hill Station, on the corner of Bolivar and Upper streets across from the UK Parking Structure #2, it shares space with Yats and Laser Quest in an old, refurbished tobacco warehouse.

"I think the space has tremendous potential," said Hautala. "The distressed warehouse feel has an innate charm. It's also a quick walk from campus so naturally we have an orientation toward campus as our primary market."

In the interest of serving a primarily campus clientele, Hautala says he has made an effort to balance quality with price. A cup of coffee at Magic Beans, with one refill, costs \$1.50,

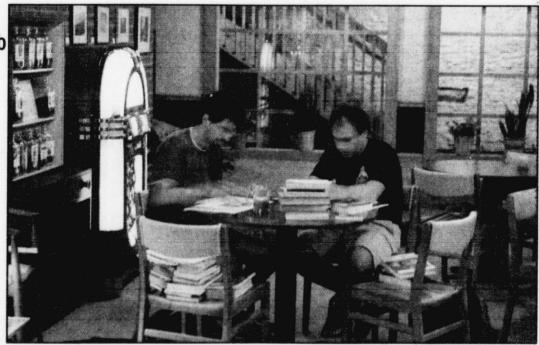
comparable to Common Grounds' \$1.36 or UK Food Services' \$1.10.

Hautala, despite his easy going, laid-back demeanor, is also a man obsessed with his product. If the smell of coffee wafts through campus, it's originating from the Sivetz fluid bed roaster Hautala plans to erect in the store by late August. According to Hautala, the roaster can turn up to 15 pounds of green coffee into the brown, drinkable stuff in about an hour.

Hautala also has plans that don't involve coffee.

"We have a music and poetry series cosponsored by WRFL," Hautala said. "We do board game tournaments featuring all of the classics, Scrabble, Risk, Monopoly. I always enjoy hosting live music events as well. We have this dinky little stage for anyone that doesn't mind playing to a small crowd."

Magic Beans is open Monday through Saturday from 10 a.m. to midnight and, according to Hautala, sporadically Sunday nights for improv theater and small one-act productions.

FALL SEMESTER STUDENT HEALTH FEE

PART-TIME STUDENTS

DEADLINE- AUGUST 25, 1999

All University of Kentucky students and Lexington Community College students are eligible to use the University Health Service for their health care. All full-time students pay a mandatory registration fee which entitles them to most services at University Health Service at no cost. **Part-time students may elect to prepay a health fee or may use the health service on a fee-for-service basis.** In addition, certain students who have not registered in classes but actively are engaged in programs leading to a degree are eligible to use the health service and pay a health fee with verification of their status from their department chairperson, dean or academic advisor each semester. Forms are available at the UK Graduate School Office and at the Health Service.

DEADLINE FOR PART-TIME STUDENTS

Individuals who elect to prepay the health fee (\$85.75) must do so by **Wednesday, Aug. 25, 1999** (Lexington Campus students should pay the fee at Student Billings, Funkhouser Building, LCC students should pay at the University Health Service cashier's office.
