

of ascertaining the true meaning of the section. that they disclosed no controversy between lower & higher education and that they & the context of the section showed clearly that no prohibition upon the legislative power such as plff contended for exists.

Kunzphrey asked me Saturday if we would agree to have their appeal advanced upon the docket of the Court of Appeals for an early decision there. Of course I declined.

Since the submission of the case I have made a much closer study of it than I had time to make before, and it seems to me our position is absolutely impregnable.

I was sorry you could not learn of your victory in time to have it help the digestion of your Thanksgiving dinner; but I suppose it will last until Christmas & serve the purpose then.
