Dear Sen,

I send enclosed with this a note to Doct Gallaher, which I wish you would send to him by some one who is going to New Washington. Get it to him as soon as convenient. I expect to return to Texas very shortly, will probably get home in a week after this. Caroline and the Baby may remain in Ken^{ty} this winter. If you see Fanna tell him to have some Cows got up that will give milk, as I cant get along without it. I have requested Doct I to tell him what to do with my boat, I want her put in good order by the time I arrive. My health is not so good as it was when I first came on. Caroline and Fanny are fat and well, enjoying the good things of this life. Give my best regards to all the family and believe me ever and truly yours
