Students rushing back to UK early

From a particular point on the sidewalk between Central Campus and Memorial Coliseum, one can see flocks of people meandering around campus.

Sorority rushees, often in groups of 15, walk up and down Rose Street from house to house, event to event.


Then there are band members, mostly in their group of 240, but sometimes broken into sections, lugging their instrument cases to and from Stoll Field, adjacent to the Student Center.

These groups have been spotting campus since Saturday. For many it's been a long week.

"I've been really tired, nervous and excited," said Christy Jones, a kinesiology sophomore who's participating in sorority rush. "Those are the three words that describe it."

"It's worth it, though," she said. Sorority rush began last Saturday when about 650 rushees converged on campus. Many of them will be united with their sororities today.

It is important that they have met many new friends, said Andrea Holmes, Panhellenic president.



For most rushees, the people they meet during rush are the first they have met on campus, she said.

They walk around and learn the campus with each other, when asked questions they answer in unison, as a group of 15.

"It's been long but fun ... and confusing ... but fun ... but fun."

On the band camp front, this week has been a blessing.

"Weather's been perfect," said Aaron Simmons, a mathematics freshman. "We've lucked-out this week — I mean it's August."

Two hundred forty band members, 105 of them new, gathered Sunday to begin camp. It won't end for them until the day before classes start.

"I hated (my first week at UK), I wanted to go home," said freshman Rhonda Bryant. The week included Bryant getting rained on and being splashed by a passing car.

But the week has turned to be pleasant for her. As she smiled, she said, "It's been fun."

Bryant's and Simmons' days have started off at 8:30 a.m. when they gather with the band to do stretches and calisthenics to warm up for the day.

The days have included about five hours practicing the pre-game show and the first of three half-time shows at Stoll Field.

Band members spend the rest of the time broken-off into their sections, often outside and sometimes in the Singletary Center for the Arts and the Fine Arts Building.

The percussion section is a common sight in front of the Singletary Center along Rose Street.

Wednesday, percussionists rested by taking in a game of football.

"Marching band is a good thing to do because you meet a lot of people," said Paul Cliburn, a music education sophomore, as drums pounded from within the Fine Arts Building behind him.

"People just want to be a part of something," he said.

For many sorority rushees, the week has been emotional as they've had to narrow their choices for a sorority from an original list of nine to a short list of three. And then one.

"It's been emotional, exciting," said merchandising sophomore Jessica McMahon.

Spectacular offers crazy introduction to semester

At the Student Center Spectacular last year, UK students started stripping.

And thousands of eager eyes watched as laughter roared through the crowd of onlookers.

The fun and the weirdness returns at 9:30 p.m. on Sunday when hypnotist Michael Anthony puts several UK students into deep and hilarious trances or causes them to "strip" or fall in love with a complete stranger.

"It's your chance to get hypnotized," said Jonathan Piercy, indoor activities chair for the Student Activities Board.

Anthony is one of many highlights of the Student Center Spectacular, which includes ventriloquism, music, comedy and the Velcro Olympics. About 3,000 people are expected at the event, SAB President Winn Stephens said.

He said everyone is invited. Besides getting hypnotized, students can catch the act of ventriloquist Willie Tyler and his dummy, Lester, both of whom appeared on "The Jeffersons."

Also, people can drape themselves in Velcro and compete in the Velcro Olympics. Participants compete by jumping, running and climbing around an inflatable Velcro jungle gym, Piercy said.

Along with being free, Piercy said the Student Center Spectacular offers students a chance to win up to \$5,000. The students compete in a game show format, and the opportunity to step into the Blizzard of Bucks, a room full of randomly floating money. What you grab is what you take, Piercy said.

Also this year, a new event, the Cardinal Roast, introduces itself as a beginning-of-the-year ritual.

"Students can get fired up about the football game (vs. Louisville at 1:30 p.m. on Aug. 30) and get free lunch," Stephens said.

People attending the roast Aug. 29 will have 16,000 chicken wings to munch on, Piercy said. UK football coach Hal Mumme will be there along with special guests, but Piercy would not tell which guests would attend.

"I'd rather not specify," he said. "I want people to be surprised."

The Spectacular is sponsored by SAB, Student Government Association, the Dean of Students Office and the Residence Hall Association. It starts at 8 p.m. Sunday. The Activities Fair runs from Monday to Tuesday. The Cardinal Roast, sponsored by SAB, SGA and the Kentucky Kernel, runs from noon-2 p.m. Friday.

Registrar: Beware of policy changes

Attention to details can help students save

It sounds simple enough: Pay close attention to the registration policies listed in the schedule book when dropping classes in order to avoid owing the University money for them.

But every year, said Associate Registrar Don Witt, students miss deadlines and end up regretting it.

"Everybody can be guilty of not reading things closely enough," he said. "Paying attention is crucial this semester, he said, since two policies have changed."

Students no longer have until the eighth week of the semester to drop a class and receive a partial refund.

The Board of Trustees decided last spring to reduce the time frame in which students can drop a class and receive any refund to four weeks. The last day to drop for a refund will be Sept. 24.

UK's old policy was out of line with its benchmarks, which are schools it uses to compare itself to, said Joan McCauley, associate vice president for planning and budget.

"The president asked us to take a look at it and come back with a revised policy if it was needed," she said.


The Institution of Planning and Budget found that UK was refunding a significant portion of the tuition for a longer time than most other schools. According to the board's official policy statement, "The revised policy will enable the University to finalize refunds earlier in the semester, allow for improved revenue forecasting, improve allocation for faculty resources and bring the refund policy more in line with other institutions."

Also this year, the University abolished the \$50 registration fee.

As a result, Witt said, "The only way not to become liable for fees is to drop before the first day of classes."

In the past, students who registered but decided not to attend classes could have their registration canceled by not paying their registration fee.

Now they must cancel the classes themselves.



Witt said he is concerned students do not know the \$50 fee has been abolished. He said those students will think their classes have been canceled because they haven't paid the fee, and then be forced to pay for classes they have decided not to take.

The registrar's office will strictly enforce the new policies, Witt said. "Classes are at a premium," he said, and students who do not drop them properly are holding up space other students may want.

Sept. 10 is the last day to pay tuition fees in full. The postmark deadline for fee payment is Aug. 29.

New priority windows streamline registration

Small alterations make UK-VIP faster

UK's Voice Information Processing network has undergone minor changes to streamline priority registration this fall.

Registration windows for students have been condensed so they open every half-hour instead of every hour, and the number of students in each window has been redistributed to prevent a backlog in the system, Assistant Registrar Michelle Nordin said.

Changes aside, normal VIP procedures are still in effect. Undergraduates and new graduate students drop or add classes by phone. Re-admitted students must register with an adviser by terminal in case their transcript needs to be evaluated, Nordin said.

Eventually UK will move toward web-based registration. The University web site gives more current information on open and closed classes. Plus, students simply prefer a computer to a phone, Nordin said.

"Students like to see some type of visual registration" rather than picking classes over the phone, Nordin said.

Since its installation in fall 1993, the system has been lauded for its efficiency. Before that students waited for as long as three hours in the mezzanine of Patterson Office Tower to register for classes.

Some college students do not have the luxury of a voice-automated registration system, Student Government Association President Melanie Cruz said.

"I have friends all over the country, and some would actually have to go back (physically) and register, Cruz said.

Even if VIP is a luxury, the system is not 100 percent problem free.

"Limit the information given, and put more responsibility on the students" said economics senior Mike Slago. "If you open up the schedule of classes, you can see half the information that takes up the first five minutes of the phone call."

Three advising conferences are left: International students register today. New freshmen and transfer students register on Monday, re-admitted and non-degree students on Tuesday.

The add/drop period for priority registered students ends Saturday; add/drop for students who late registered runs from Aug. 27 to Sept. 3, and costs \$40. The last day to officially drop a course or cancel registration using UK-VIP is Aug. 26; the last day to enter a class is Sept. 3, and the last day to withdraw from a course is Oct. 24.





Cats kick off aerial assault

Offense attracting spectators

The fall semester is approaching, and with it comes the traditional excitement of autumn sports. The turf is green, the lines are painted and the air brings in the whiff of dirty cleats and sweaty helmets.

Yes, the UK football season has arrived once again.

The Cats will kick off their 1997 season on Aug. 30 against the University of Louisville. This intrastate rival will be the first game for new head coach Hal Mumme, whose aerial-assault offense should keep the scorekeepers busy and the cameramen moving.

Mumme's style of play has also stirred up an impressive amount of fan interest.

The general public's ticket allotment for the U of L game has already sold out. Rodney Stiles, UK's director of administrative services, said the change may also boost the level of student involvement.

"Any change will spur interest with the new offense (Mumme) plans to run, I'm sure everyone is intrigued to see what the success will be," Stiles said. "There will be a greater amount of student interest, whether they succeed or not. It will be fun to watch."

Last year's UK-U of L game spurred considerable student interest — student attendance was a season high — and this year's

edition looks to be no different. Students wanting to attend the game will need to get to the ticket lines early.

During the offseason, the UK Athletic Department voted to redistribute 2,000 tickets from the student pool into the general public pool. This makes it even more difficult for students to wait until the last minute to pick up tickets.

This leaves only 9,500 seats; take out the band seats, and the number goes down to about 9,000.

Student tickets are scheduled to go on sale Aug. 25, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Only full-time students with a valid UK student ID will be

able to purchase these for a fee of \$5.

Unlike the perhaps more familiar basketball ticket distribution system, football tickets will be dish out on a first come, first serve basis at the Memorial Coliseum ticket window.

Stiles anticipates guest tickets to be in great demand this year because of the public sell out, which provides an example of supply and demand at its best.

"Those people who are shut out now and can't get a public seat are going to go through the students to get one," Stiles said. "Because of the student interest, there may not even be guest tickets

Academic woes plague UK receivers

With all of the hoopla around UK head coach Hal Mumme's pass-happy offense, one big question remains:

Who will catch the 50 or so passes predicted to be thrown each game?

Because of academic problems, wide receivers Quentin McCord and Chad Spencer are most likely gone from the team. Couple that with the already departed Norm Mason, another academic casualty, and the Cats may have a depth problem at wide receiver.

"Those guys didn't take care of business so they won't be there," Mumme said. "And I'm probably going to forget their names pretty quick."

Mason finished with 14 receptions, good for third on the Cats' last year while McCord caught 12 passes in his freshman season.

Spencer was a tight end last season and finished with 10 receptions. He earned a spot on the Freshman All-Southeastern Conference team but was expected to move to wide receiver this season.

"I really hoped that Chad would be there for us," quarterback Tim Couch said. "He was really a great player for us but we've got a couple of freshmen that will be more than willing to take his job."

Misfire

Despite accidentally shooting roommate Omar Smith in the buttocks with a rifle, UK center Jason Watts' role on

the team has not changed. "He's still our starting center," Mumme said. "He's got some legal things he's gotta do and he'll work through those."

"He's already been disciplined by me and I'm not going to discuss the discipline because it does not involve a suspension."

Watts was originally charged with a felony, but the charge was later reduced to a misdemeanor.

Last season, Watts started every game at center and was the only offensive lineman to start every game for the Wildcats.

Because of the shooting, Smith spent two days in the hospital and lost about 20 pounds. His football status for 1997 remains in limbo.

"Omar was about the eighth lineman at the end of spring and obviously he's going to be hindered a little bit," Mumme said.

"We'll just see how it goes. Omar has never had a redshirt year so it wouldn't be out of the question that we (redshirt him)."

Logan's Run to Richmond

After being arrested for shoplifting in the offseason and later suspended from the team, running back Derrick Logan decided to transfer to Eastern Kentucky.

Logan rushed for 766 yards and was named SEC Freshman of the Year. With Logan gone, Anthony White is the only running back with any semblance of experience this year. He rushed for a total of 51 yards last season.

Clowns push the envelope of bad taste

Come one, come all. Step inside the Dark Carnival where you will be assailed by nightmarish visions of freaks, jugglers and death.

This is the world of the Insane Clown Posse as it appears on their new CD, *The Great Milenko*.

This is the fourth release for Violent J and Shaggy 2 Dope, but the first on the Island Records label. The Clowns were booted from their previous label owned by the Walt Disney Corporation.

The rather colorful language the ICP is so fond of didn't quite fit in with Mickey Mouse's image.

Now that ICP has full creative freedom at Island Records, they have pulled out all the stops, and it shows on *The Great Milenko*.

The CD opens with a sometimes spooky, sometimes funny spoken intro by none other than Alice Cooper himself.

The band is from Detroit's Southwest side. Their upbringing in the ghetto heavily influences their own unique style of rap.

Song after song on *The Great Milenko* tells of violent deaths of those the ICP sees fit to destroy through Milenko.

Milenko is what ICP refers to a Necromaster, one who uses magic through the dead.

The album itself represents the fourth Joker Card. After the sixth Joker Card the world is supposed to come to a rather violent end.

The Great Milenko tempts people with illusions of better lifestyles built upon wrongdoing.

Violent J explains in a news release, "The fourth Joker Card is a warning that man must look past

these illusions and see the evil judgment that the Great Milenko is really offering."

Most of the music on the album is rather unremarkable except for its sheer shock value. Some of the songs like "Hokus Pokus" and "House of Illusions" do have pretty catchy choruses.

"House of Illusions" is the first single on the CD and is one of the more disturbing songs on the album.

The Clowns rap about a house of illusions where wrongdoers walk in and don't walk out. They are systematically taken out at the hands of the Great Milenko.

One of the most enduring

qualities of the CD is the spooky comedy pieces tacked onto the ends of some of the songs. One of the funniest is a fake suicide call where the hotline operator tells the distressed caller, "Do it fucker! / Bring me the gun and I'll do it for ya!"

It is not unlike a really morbid version of the Jerky Boys.

Some of the songs have amusing lyrics, but the music itself is not all that great.

The song, "What is a Juggalo?" is one of those hilarious offerings. "He just don't care / He might try to put a weave in his nut hair," ICP raps in its most amusing tune.

'Ponette' packs poignant punch

In the film industry, children usually serve one purpose: looking cute and drawing a few "ohhh, how cute" from audiences. The new French film *Ponette* shatters the kid-flick status-quo with its thoughtful, heartfelt portrayal of a 4-year-old's encounter with death and religion.

Unlike films like *Jerry Maguire* and *Home Alone* which offer steady diets of empty closeups of their smiling children, *Ponette* tackles difficult material and does so while looking damn cute.

It tells the story of its title character, a 4-year-old girl who lives through a car accident that killed her mother. After learning of the death, she is bombarded with a variety of opinions regarding the presence and power of God.

Her father is a devout non-believer, her aunt discusses the possibility of her mother's return and her cousins provide their own 4-year-old wisdom on heaven.

It all leads to a confusion

that leaves Ponette spending entire days in sadness waiting for the arrival of her mother. Ultimately, kid's logic prevails and Ponette expresses intentions to die so she can live with her mother in heaven.

The young phenomenon Victoire Thevisol won the Best Actress Award at last year's Venice Film Festival with a surprisingly controlled and emotional performance.

Writer/Director Jacques Doillon shows a delicate eye for capturing the moment and offers a truly authentic look at empty closeups of the pants of learning. His ability to offer poignant subject matter through the conversations of 4-year-olds delivers the film's true brilliance.

He only falls short of achieving perfection with his concluding images that take place at her mother's grave. The viewer is left pondering whether the happy ending was really for the betterment of the child or a just a step to further confuse the situation.

Either way, *Ponette* explores important human issues in a manner so uncommon to film that it would be a shame to miss.
