Central City, Jan. 20 — The men
employed in the mines here
went out on a strike this
morning, demanding 33-5 cents
per bushel for digging. The
drivers want \$1.75 per day.
J. C. Dupont notified the committee
this morning that he could
pay only three cents, the usual
price, and \$1.65 for driving.
