500 LABORERS

NEGROES PREFERRED TO
WORK IN SHIPYARDS AT 35c
AN HOUR.

President Frank L. McKay, of the University, who is State director of public service reserve and of employment service, has received a call for 600 laborers from Kentucky to work in the government shipyards. Colored men are preferred and the pay will be 35-cents an hour. The men are needed before the end of this week and telegrams have been sent out to the local labor directors over the State.
