— The Ancient Order of United Workmen is not to be confounded with the Knights of Labor or other organizations in which the word "labor" appears as a catch-word. It has no connection with Trade Unions or "Assemblies," whatever may be their foundation or objects. It is a purely fraternal and beneficent Order, secret for protection against fraud, and does not consider labor, political, or religious questions under any circumstances. During the month of December the Order collected \$264,438 50 beneficiary moneys, and distributed \$262,000 to the families of deceased brothers. Its actual membership on December 1 was 178,595.
