

CHRISTOPHER GREENUP, Esq. governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, to all whom these presents shall come;

Greeting: KNOW YE, That by virtue and in consideration of an act of Assembly for the endowment of Certain Seminaries of learning and for other purposes there is granted by the said Commonwealth; unto the Trustees of the Hartford Academy

A certain Tract or Parcel of Land, containing *Ninety acres by survey bearing date the third day of June One thousand Eight hundred and Six lying and being in the County of Livingston on the waters of a Branch running out of a Pond called Shelby Pond and into Livingston creek a Branch of the Cumberland river and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at the most Eastwardly corner of a two hundred acre survey made for Hendley Russell assignee of James Jolly on a Commissioners Certificate No 2726 at a forked black Oak then North twenty East eighty poles to a white Oak and black Oak in So Needs line then with Needs line North twenty eight East seventy two poles to a black Oak corner to said Needs then North sixty two East twenty poles across the Pond branch to a Maple, then North twenty eight West twenty poles to two Elms on said Pond branch then South sixty five West one hundred and seventy poles with So Needs line to a hickory black Oak and black Gum then South forty one West twenty poles to a black Oak and hickory corner to said Russell then South seventy East two hundred poles with Russells line to the Beginning.*

With its appurtenances TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of Land, with its appurtenances, to the said Trustees of the Hartford Academy and their Successors

and heirs, forever.
