

The Commonwealth of Kentucky Ohio County (Big)

Be it Remembered that on the 18th day of February 1815. Joshua Griffith Farmer and William M. Farland Sen. Farmer both of said County, Came before me Baxter Davis a Justice of the peace for said County and each acknowledged themselves justly indebted to the said Commonwealth that is to say the said Joshua Griffith in the just sum of one Hundred Dollars and the said William M. Farland in the just sum of Fifty Dollars to be respectively seized of their Goods & Chattels Lands & Tenements to the proper use & benefit of the said Commonwealth, if the said Joshua Griffith shall fail in performing the condition under written

The condition of the Above Recognizance is such that if the Above bounden Joshua Griffith shall personally appear at the next County Court to be holden in said County of Ohio then & there to abide the Orders of said Court enjoined on him and also to abide a bill which may be preferred against him by Calenor Ashley a Single Woman of said County for his getting her with Child of a Male Bastard Child and not to depart said Court until regularly discharged, then this Recognizance to be void & of none effect otherwise to be & remain in full force & Virtue in Law - Signed Sealed & Acknowledged in presence of
