The condition of the above obligation is that if the a-
bove bound Martin Vanado as Executor of the last will &
Testament of Daniel Holt deceased do make a true and
Perfect inventory of all and singular the goods Chattels &
Credits of the said Deceased which have or shall come to the
Hands Possession or Knowledge of the said Martin Vanado
or into the Hands or possession of any other person or persons
for him and the same do made do Exhibit unto the County
Court of Ohio County at such time as he shall be thereto requi-
red by the said Court and the same goods Chattels &
Credits do well and truly administer according to Law
and make a just and true account of all his actions &
Doings therein when thereunto required by the said Court
and further do well and truly pay and deliver all the legacies
contained and specified in the said will as far as the said
goods Chattels ~~and~~ Credits will Extend according to the
value thereof and as the Law shall Charge him
