Such would be little short of tragic, especially since the need for revision is so apparent and is favored by so many fraternity men. It is therefore time for action through one channel or another. The two proposed methods which offer themselves, namely the six weeke' system and the whole semester plan, have heretefore been explained in the KERNEL, and one or the other han been approved by almost all Greeks. The former satisfies even the most conservatives that there can be no doubt that steferred rushing of some kind is wanted.
