

When spring break is mentioned,
Cancun, Florida, the Bahamas and South
Padre Island are usually the first places that
come to mind. Never-ending partying,
nights filled with moments that are never
remembered the next day and lazy days on
the beach sound ideal, but how many students can really afford to live out an extravagant spring break every year?
Most students fit the typical stereotype
of being poor college students who can
barely afford a decent meal. But there are
great places to travel all over the country
that won't break the bank and are guaranteed to entertain.

For those searching for somewhere that
isn't too far to drive, Gatlinburg, Tenn.,
Tenn., has become a popular and inexpensive place to visit. With several tourist attractions and spectacular views from the
Appalachian Mountains, Gatlinburg, Tenn.,
offers brand new cabins in the mountains
that can be rented very cheaply with a
large group of people. Some of the cabins
sleep up to 10 people.

A tip for booking cabins is to up it early for cheaper rates.

Another beautiful and exciting place to visit that is sometimes overlooked is Savannah, Ga. Known for its Southern charm, down-home cooking and famous river walk, which offers plenty of shops and

restaurants.

The city is also one of the most haunted in the world after Savannah's historical role during the Civil War. For tourists brave enough, there are nightly ghost tours by horse and buggy. For those wanting a great tan, the beach is fairly close as well. The drive to Savannah is about nine hours but plane tickets for students can usually be purchased cheaply from Southwest Arlines or Web sites such as Orbitz, Expedia and Travelocity. Hotels right outside of downtown Savannah are the places to book. Holiday Inn — Savannah Midtown offers a room for four people at \$115 per person for six nights.

Chicago is also a very exciting city to visit— and inexpensive, too, with one-way flights from Louisville frequently under \$100. springbreakdiscounts.com or studenttravel-breaks.com. The key to booking these trips is to start searching early for the best pack-ages. The shorter the trip, the cheaper the packages will be, but they will also be sold the quickest.

A good resource that has helped stu-dents plan their trips all over the world for reasonable prices is STA Travel located in the Student Center on campus. Not only does STA offer packages to spring break hot spots but they also offer adventure travel packages throughout the Americas and beyond.

"If students want to visit Europe, spring

break is one of the best times to make the trip," said Jake Cunningham, travel adviser at STA Travel. "Europe's low season is during the time of spring break and hotels and flights are usually much cheaper than in the summer."

The key things to keep in mind in order to save money when planning for spring break are to book early, consider staying for fewer nights and to look at cities that are not spring break hot spots.

Whether you decide to spend your money on an extravagant spring break or a low-key trip, plan ahead and be wary of unrealistic packages and offers.





The first tip to enjoy a spring break
vacation in Lexington would be to simply let the week be a time to unwind.
Most vacations end up taking more

get a massage or a facial—do anything not done during a hectic semester

some sort. There are classes in
Lexington to fit all interests, from daning and kitchboxing to cooking or pottery. These will provide creative outlets
in a variety of topics and they may even
turn into something more than just a
weeklong experiment.

Gather friends who are not on a beach someplace and make a dinner date. For an upscale dining experience, consider Portofino's on Main Street or Metropol on West Short Street. Other local favorites include Joe Bologna's on West Maxwell, deSha's on North Broadway in Victorian Square and the Atomic Cafe on North Limestone. Instead of going to one of Lexington's large chain movie theaters, go catch a movie at the Kentucky Theatre on Main Street. Or go to the local comedy club, Comedy Off Broadway, located in Lexington Green off Nicholasville Road.

If a day trip is feasible, there are several hot spots in central Kentucky to check out. Go on a tour of a bourbon distillery or a vineyard. Nearby, there are four distinct bourbon distilleries, Wild Turkey, Woodford Reserve, Four Roses and Buffalo Trace. For a local vineyard, check out Taino Winery and Vineyards located out Tates Creek Road.

Newport on the Levee is less than two hours north and offers the best of nightliffe, dining and entertainment in Northern Kentucky.




