Consideration of
Case of Mr.
Milward.

The business of the meeting was to consider the case of Mr. Milward, who had struck his superior officer. This case had come up from the Board of Discipline, with the recommendation to suspend the offender for the remainder of the Term. The matter was passed temporarily, as Mr. Milward was not present to offer defense.

The matter of admitting students below the grade of freshman to membership in the Kappa Alpha Fraternity was considered. Final action was postponed, to take up again the case of Mr. Milward, he having meanwhile come in. After hearing his statement, the Faculty concurred in the motion of Mr. Nelson, that the recommendation of the Board of Discipline be adopted, and Mr. Milward be suspended for the remainder of the ^{collegiate} year.
