

CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT entered into this 30th day of Feb,
A.D. 1919, between the WISCONSIN STEEL COMPANY, INC. of Benham, Ky., party of
the first part, and J. F. CREECH of Poorfork, Harlan County, Ky., party of
the second part, ^{and Grant Hagg} WITNESSETH:

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF the sum of One Thousand Seventy-Seven
Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$1077.50), the party of the second part agrees to
construct a church building, as per blueprint attached herewith. This
building to be constructed complete with number one (#1) cedar shingle roof;
all framing and finished lumber to be of number two (#2) common or better;
all foundation piers to be of stone laid in cement mortar down to frost line;
foundation to be built of 6x8's; joists to be 2x10's on two (2) foot centers;
two (2) coats of paint to be furnished on outside; two (2) coats of stain on
inside of building and one (1) flue as per specifications.

The party of the second part agrees to construct this building com-
plete, furnishing all labor and necessary material, and to do the work in a
satisfactory and workmanlike manner, same to be approved by the engineer of
the Wisconsin Steel Company, Inc.

The party of the first part agrees to pay to the party of the second
part, the above named sum in two (2) payments-fifty per cent (50%) of the
agreed price to be paid when the building is fifty per cent (50%) complete
and seventy-five per cent (75%) of the lumber on the ground, the balance of
the payment to be paid on completion of the building.
