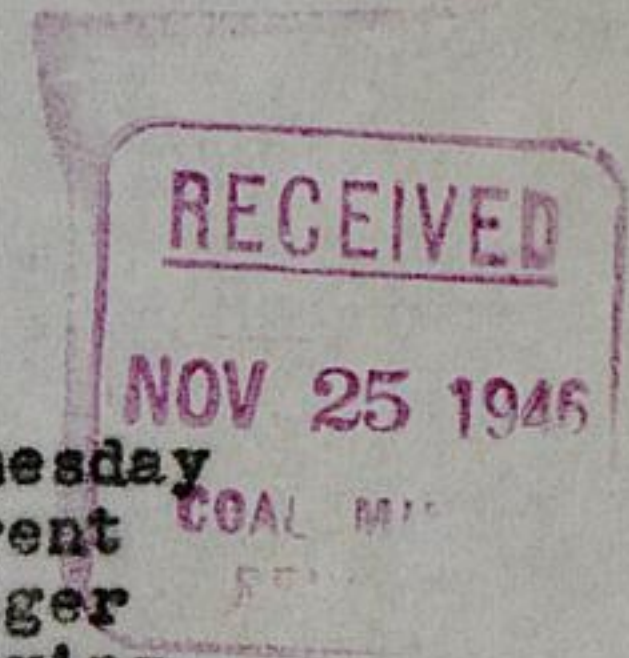

HOTEL OPERATION



Confirming my conversation with you last Wednesday morning, it will be all right to forego the hotel rent for the month of October on the basis that the manager will only have about \$34. left for herself after paying all the expenses including rent. As I previously stated, a careful monthly check of her accounts should be the basis on which rent is to be charged, and you should see that she clears somewhere in the neighborhood of \$100. per month for herself.

I agree with your suggestion that the hotel rates should be carefully reviewed to the end of making this operation come out a little more even.

I wish you would go over this matter carefully and advise me what you intend to do about it, if anything, and when would be the most opportune time.
