PAINTING AND REPAIRING TOWN BUILDINGS

Dear Mr. Rose:

We attach hereto duplicate copies of our Appropriation Request No. 125-A dated May 16, 1938, in the amount of \$7,500.00 to cover the painting and repairing of town buildings.

This request is made for an "A" Appropriation yearly for the necessary repairs and painting to approximately one-fifth of the buildings in the town as we endeavor to get around the whole town in every five year period in order to keep the houses and buildings up in good shape. This work, of course, is in addition to the regular upkeep and repair work and is done every year. Usually we set up an amount of \$15,000.00 to cover this work, however during periods of depression this amount has been cut and we are cutting it this year to \$7,500.00. We originally set up \$15,000.00 in our budget.

We would ask that you please approve this Appropriation Request as we would like to get started on this work as soon as possible.
