Dear Sir:

The new equipment which Mr. Stevenson has ordered for power additions covers one 300 K. W. motor generator set and one 100 H. P. motor for same, and he adds the following clause in his letter:

"I may mention that item 6, the 300 KW motor generator, and item 9, the 100 H. P. motor, are not items on account of the new development but are essential for the proper operation of the old mine and a proper part of the comprehensive power improvement to be provided for the whole property".

This was in a letter he wrote to Mr. Edgar covering the purchase.

I have sent in requisition as per Mr. Stevenson's request, however the question comes up from this department as to where the charge shall be placed for the 300 K. W. motor generator and the 100 H. P. motor as I understand we have no appropriation to cover these two items and they were not considered in the budget. Will you please advise Mr. O'Connell where this charge shall be made and oblige.
