Dear Parent:

The Benham School is providing a program in folk dancing for the students and for the community. This is merely a group of rhythm or singing games, which are being taught by Miss Christenson, who for many years has been teaching this work at Pine Mountain Settlement School. On Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday nights of this week, from 7:00 to 8:30, these games will be taught by Miss Christenson to any person who cares to attend. No student may come unless that student is sixteen years old or more. Friday night, however, will be a general community night on which all people are welcome, regardless of age.

In the spring of 1936, Miss Christenson spent a week with us, doing this same kind of work. We think we are fortunate to secure her. We believe that you would like this activity, if you could see the program in action. Whether you wish to participate or merely look on, we encourage you to come any night this week. There is no charge whatsoever.
