Gentlemen:- Attention of Mr. W. H. Boatright, Chief Engineer.

Re: Nancy Shepherd - J. B. Galloway, etc.

The other day I incidentally heard the above case called in Court and a statement made that the defendant, J. B. Galloway was filing an answer to the plaintiff's petition and a cross-petition against J. L. Creech and the Wisconsin Steel Company. I have gotten the papers in this case with a view of determining what it is all about. As far as I know, however, no summons has been served on the Wisconsin Steel Company as must be done before it is necessary for it to take any action in court. The situation as shown by the pleadings in this case is as follows:

The plaintiff sues the defendant for \$1,000.00 setting up the fact that she has a lien upon two tracts of land bounded as follows:

"Certain property located in Harlan County, Kentucky, on Poor Fork on the Cumberland River, and described and bounded as follows:

Beginning at the stake in the line of a tract of land owned by Jacob Creech and said stake in the Northeast corner of Jacob Dixon's line; thence South 61 West with the said Dixon's Southwest line to the middle of Looney Creek; thence up said Creek with the meanders of same to H.L. Huff's line; thence a Northwardly course with H. L. Huff's line to Jacob Creech's line to the beginning.

Tract #2. Also another tract of land lying and being in Harlan County, Kentucky on Poor Fork on the Cumberland River and described as follows:

Begining on H. L. Huff's South-west corner of the tract of land conveyed to him by A. B. Creech which is in Wisconsin Steel Company's line; thence Westwardly with the said Wisconsin Steel Company's line to the County Road bridge near the old store building known as the E. C. Blair building; thence Westwardly with the Harry White's line; thence Southwardly with H. L. Huff's East line to the beginning."
