A special meeting of the faculty was held in the faculty room on Tuesday, September 28th., 1915, President Barker presiding. Quorum present.

President Barker stated that the purpose of the meeting was to hear the report of the Discipline Committee, and at the request of the President, Professor Mathews as Chairman, read the following report:

"BE IT RESOLVED, by the faculty of State University in special convocation assembled, that all of the male members of the Sophomore Class of State University are hereby suspended for five (5) days. If within that time any of the suspended men will sign the following statement, to wit:

"On my honor as a gentleman I hereby declare that I have not been engaged in the cutting of any Freshman's hair within the present University school term."

he is to be, in the discretion of the President, reinstated."

After a general discussion, Dr. Kastle offered the following substitute, which was adopted:

"BE IT RESOLVED that, having confessed to participating in hazing, Messrs. Robert Wright, H. W. Whaley, D. C. Carson and J. F. McWhorter are hereby dismissed from this University and are required to leave the grounds at once."

On motion the faculty adjourned.
