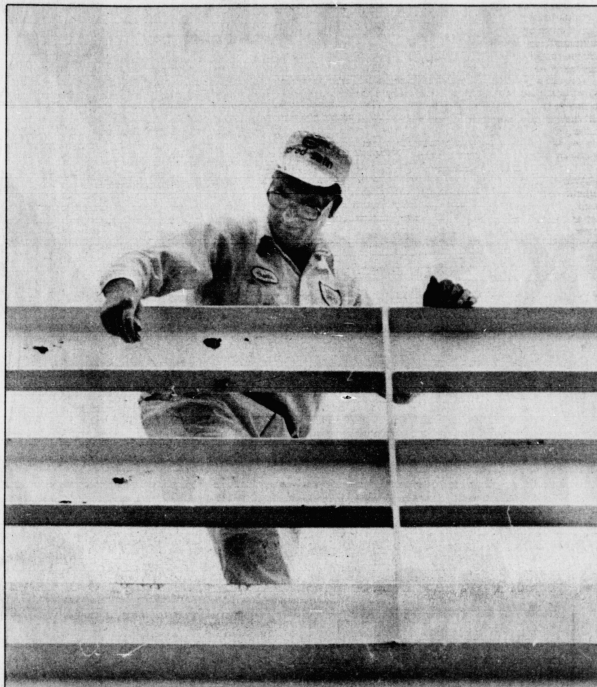

Add/Drop requires patience, stamina, and a No. 2 pencil

Memorial Coliseum comes alive with activity tomorrow as thousands of preregistered students return to campus and try to change their class schedules.

Whether you have changed your mind or your schedule of classes has changed, Add/Drop is an experience for both amateurs and veterans. Centralized Add/Drop has been held in the Coliseum since the late 1950s and is usually held on the Tuesday before classes begin, but students may change their schedules until Aug. 30.

New students who haven't registered in advance may do so today. George Dexter, associate registrar, estimated 1,500 new students will register today and "the average number of 2,500" will Add/Drop tomorrow.

On Wednesday, the College of Arts and Sciences will hold its Add/Drop in Buell Armory and moves to the Arts and Sciences Office in the Patterson Office Tower after Wednesday.

All other colleges have Add/Drop in their dean's offices until Aug. 30. Students are allowed inside the Coliseum after the scheduled time for each letter according to the students' last name. Any student arriving after the allotted time should go to the late arrival table inside the Coliseum.

Add/Drop is disliked by students because they "have to wait in lines to see if space is available and there are limited resources and a large demand for some classes," Dexter said.

Students should find their designated line and wait until it goes in-

side the Coliseum. There will be people inside asking for your UK ID, and they will hand you a permit card for adding and dropping classes.

It is important that each person receives an instruction sheet and Add/Drop slip on the tables in the Coliseum. The instruction sheet will tell you where each subject is located in the Coliseum.

Dexter said, "Students need their schedules, so they know the classes that they are actually enrolled in."

It is not unusual that the time and class you want has already been closed; therefore, it might be helpful to have alternative classes and times in case you can not get a class you want.

To be on the safe side, you should add any classes you want before dropping those you have, because you may not be able to get the schedule you want.

You must have a No. 2 pencil to fill out the cards that will be given to you by people at the tables. Each card has the subject heading for each class that you add or drop.

After you have filled out the cards and the Add/Drop slip, take them along with your permit card to the dean's table of your college, and you will have finished changing your schedule.

Keep the pink copy of the Add/Drop slip you are handed in case the computer does not register your new schedule.

Salaries increase to meet those at benchmark institutions

Summertime means work for University administrators

While most students were busy with summer jobs or spending their time basking in the sun, more than 7,000 students attended classes.

University administrators didn't get much of a vacation, but they did get a boost—a six percent salary increase was approved at the June 21 Board of Trustees meeting.

The salary raise finally brought faculty pay "up to other benchmark institutions," President Otis Singletary said. He said he hoped the pay increase would result in attracting more quality professors to UK.

The \$363.9 million budget is a seven percent rise over last year's budget. No provisions for any budget cuts were included and Singletary said that UK's budget could not withstand any cuts from Frankfort.

"If such a cut does materialize, funds budgeted to address maintenance and equipment needs, deferred as a result of previous cuts will have to be used to cover it," Singletary said.

Also during the meeting, two major personnel changes were announced. Vice president for administration Donald Clapp announced his retirement. Clapp, who has been with the University for 20 years, said he will leave his position on Aug. 31.

The College of Engineering received a new dean. Ray M. Bowen of Rice University

was named to fill the vacancy left by former dean Roger Eichorn. Bowen, who has been a member of several national consulting firms, said he plans to lead UK in a "revolution" covering all dimensions of engineering.

Over the summer, students discovered that getting exemptions from the mandatory health fee may be a difficult task. David Bradford, president of the Student Govern-

ment Association, said, "I've not heard anything officially yet, but I'm beginning to have suspicions that painfully few students will get exemptions."

Singletary was indignant following a release of a consultant's report to the state Council on Higher Education recommending the merger of UK's dental school with UL's dental school. The report also recommended a merger of the two schools' ruling bodies

into "one governing board."

Singletary said there were flaws with the report, citing inaccuracies with both the data collected and the conclusions made by the consultants.

Other changes recommended in the report included limiting the number of students in Kentucky's law and dental schools. The recommendation does not apply to the medical

schools, however, as the number of medical students is decreasing, not increasing.

The report said the state is below average in retaining the doctors it graduates. Only 45 percent of UK medical graduates stay in Kentucky.

In other news over the summer, the founder of a Lexington anti-drunk driving organization was arrested for the second time of driving while under the influence.

Charles Malkus, a former UK student and founder of Lexington Against Drunk Driving Service, was rearrested on June 17 for DUI and for driving without automobile insurance.

Malkus, who said in the October 13, 1983, edition of the Kernel following his first arrest, was quoted as saying, "I will never think about drinking—even one beer—and driving."

After his second arrest, Malkus said he had "no comments at this point."

Plans for a new \$5 million aquatic center were announced. The new swimming area will include separate pools for diving and swimming, a deck area, lobby, shower, machine and drying rooms. Cliff Hagan, athletics director, said plans are also being studied to include a sundeck, classrooms, vending areas and a 1,500 spectator seating area.

The new center is scheduled to be built either as an addition to the Seaton Center or in the lot adjacent to the Shively Sports Center. The aquatic center should be completed in three years at the earliest, Hagan said.

Vice president leaves 20-year career in higher education

President Otis Singletary dropped a bombshell at the June 21 Board of Trustees meeting when he announced the resignation of Vice President for Administration Donald Clapp.

Singletary said Clapp's decision was "a great loss for the University. I really regret his decision to leave. . . . He'll be extremely difficult to replace."

"This is a really tough decision for me," Clapp said at the time, "because I have a very close relationship with Dr. Singletary."

Clapp has been a part of UK for the past 20 years—first as a research assistant for the executive vice president and later as

budget director. In 1973, he was named executive assistant to the president, the title of which was eventually changed to vice president for administration.

His legacy at the University includes the extensive reorganization process which the Board began last summer. It was the complete restructuring of UK that kept him here another year, he said.

"I really went through sort of a two-stage process," Clapp said about his decision to leave. "Four years ago, there really weren't any other positions in higher education I wanted."

"Then, a couple of years ago, I decided I had some obligations (the budget cuts) to stay and see those through. I decided to stay for another year to help President Singletary put the reorganization in place."

"My commitment was to stay just until the summer," he said. Clapp will be leaving the University on

- c) External transfers who were accepted prior to June 1, 1983.

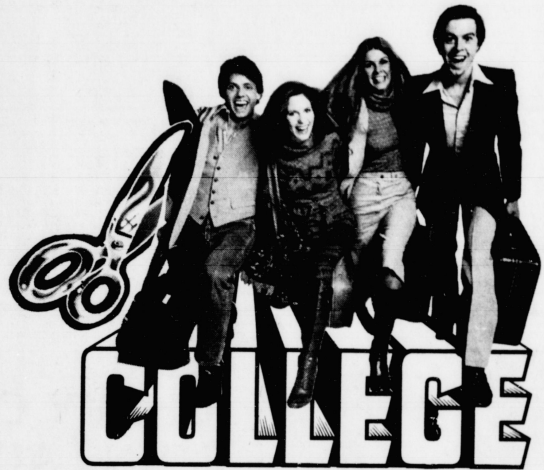
