My dear Annee

Thursday

Your letter was received yesterday but Helen was so ill that I could not get time to write a word to you, she is better to day looks very bad indeed. I hope now she will get well. Fanny came down to see her on Friday and was taken sick here and is here quite sick yet she has a dreadful Throat all the Family here had it now but the Dr. there is a great deal of it through the country three or four cases in town now. Mrs Lee died last Monday, I sent her the Len of Lord and directed it to be left at the stage office I paid for carrying it. I do hope she will get it. There is a great deal of excitement here about the War. There are a thousand or two men going to start out of Mont gomery and Beth to day for the mountains to try and ret
