MOTION TO RESTORE CASE TO ACTIVE DOCKET FOR THE PURPOSE OF MODIFICATION OF FINAL JUDGMENT AND DESEGREGATION ORDER AND FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADDING PARTY AND DESIGNATING CLASS REPRESENTATIVE

Come now the plaintiffs herein, by counsel, and respectfully move the Court that it exercise its inherent power to protect the integrity of its final judgment and desegregation order entered in the above-titled case and to modify same to accommodate changed circumstances. Specifically, plaintiffs move the Court that it take the following actions with respect to said final judgment and desegregation order:

- (1) That it restore the case to the active docket for the purpose of considering the present motion and granting the relief requested herein.
- (2) That it declare that the final judgment in this case entered on July 16, 1978, which affirmed the continuing nature of the desegregation order of July 30, 1975, as amended, including the student assignment methodology required by said order, remains binding on the defendant, Board of Education of Jefferson County, Kentucky, unless and until said judgment and desegregation order is modified by further order of this Court.
