



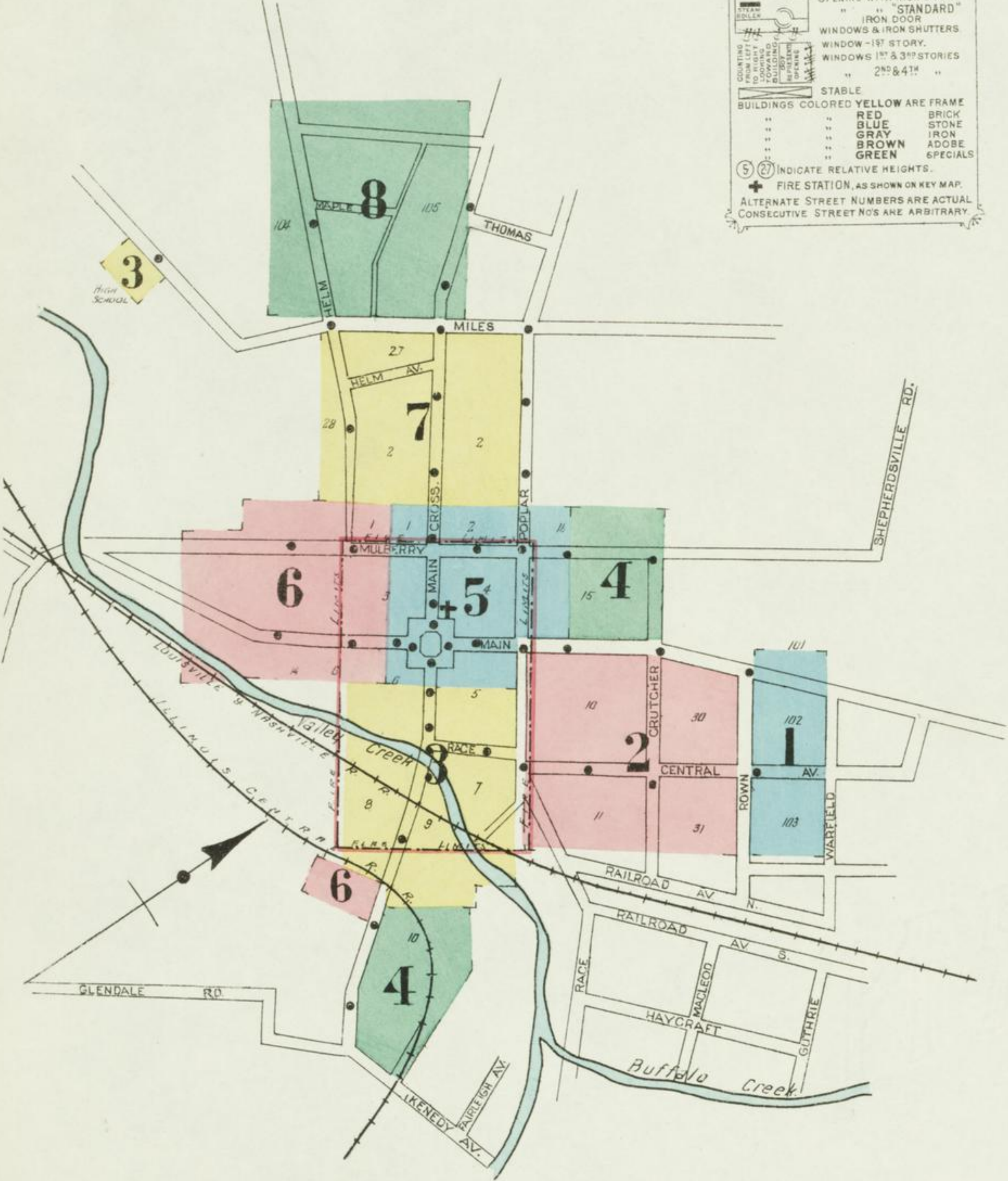

**WATER FACILITIES:**  
Owned by town, built in 1886, gravity & direct pumping system, supplied by 150,000 gal. stand pipe & two Smith Valve duplex pumps, cap'd v. 250,000 gals. per 24 hours each. Stand pipe located 3/4 mile S.W. of Court Ho. & elev'd 95' above center of town. Domestic pressure 45 lbs. Fire pressure 80 lbs. per sq. inch. 6 miles 4" cast iron water pipe, average age 8 years. Average daily consumption not known. 44 double hydrants.

**FIRE DEPT.:**  
Volunteer company, 30 men. 2 hose reels, 1,000 ft. hose. 1 H.A. L. Truck. Apparatus drawn by horses. Alarm sounded by bell on Court Ho. Grades: practically level. Streets: partly paved. Public lights electric.
