(10/27/1844 - ?) Daughter of Wm. B. and Nancy E. Rogers. She lived in the Blue Spring Grove area, Barren County, Ky. (about 8 miles north of Glasgow, Ky.)

Letter to Annie B[yrd Rogers] from unidentified person, Rich Grove, Ky. Remarks re social life and mutual friends. The writer asks the receiver to inform her brother Bird [John Byrd Rogers, later a major in the Confederate forces] that 50 men now belonged to the military company, presumably in the Rich Grove area.

3/12/1861

Letter to Annie from Mary J. Bagby, Mound City, Mo. Personal letter re relatives and mutual friends. Brief remarks re amount of livestock on the farm and corn prices.

7/21/?
