

NANCEY E. ROGERS PAPERS (addendum)

2/15/1857 Letter from Isaac Newland to Cousin Nancy
[Presumably Nancy E. Rogers, 6/20/1806 - 2/6/1889]

Newland mentions a letter he had written to Nancy five weeks ago, no doubt the letter of 1/8/1857, and brings her up to date about his sale of property that most likely belonged originally to her late father, John Bagby (1762-1834), and upon his death was inherited by Nancy's mother, Matilda Bagby, who had recently died on 2/12/1856.

Newland indicates that the sale earned \$1,100 to \$1,200. He hired out the Negroes at good prices. The [Negro] Boys hired out for \$125 and \$135 apiece. Newland rented out the unidentified farm for \$150.
