# TOURS

Larry Greenwood reports that about 1,700 freshmen were given library tours last week and everything went smoothly. During this week about 500 students received instructional tours.

### TRANSFERRING PHONE CALLS

Phone calls from off campus to the library can be transferred to other on-campus offices via a simple procedure. If library staff members use this transfer capability, patrons may be spared calling 2 or 3 different departments themselves.

The procedure to transfer a call is as follows: 1) make sure the caller is off-campus; 2) tell the person you are transferring their call and give him the number (in case the call is disconnected); 3) depress the button briefly and wait for a dial tone; 4) dial the 5 digit UK number and explain that a transferred call is coming in; 6) hang up — your party will automatically be connected with the new number.

## BLUEGRASS POETRY CIRCUIT

David Farrell recently chartered the Bluegrass poetry circuit, a non-profit organization to promote the writing of poetry by students at colleges and universities in central Kentucky.
