

Minutes of the Meeting of the Executive Committee of the Board of Trustees of the University of Kentucky, Tuesday, August 10, 1976.

The Executive Committee of the Board of Trustees of the University of Kentucky met at 1:00 p. m. (Eastern Daylight Time) on Tuesday, August 10, 1976, in the Board Room on the 18th floor of the Patterson Office Tower on the Lexington campus with the following members answering the call of the roll: Mr. William B. Sturgill, Mr. William R. Black, Mr. Albert G. Clay, Mr. Richard E. Cooper, and Mr. George W. Griffin. Professor Paul Sears, Ex-Officio Secretary, was present as were Professor Michael Adelstein and Mr. James A. Sutherland, members of the Board of Trustees. The University administration was represented by President Otis A. Singletary; Vice Presidents Lewis W. Cochran, Robert Zumwinkle, Stanley Wall, Peter P. Bosomworth, Raymond R. Hornback, Jack C. Blanton, and Donald B. Clapp; Dr. Robert M. Drake, Special Assistant to the President; and Mr. John Darsie, Legal Counsel. Representatives of the various news media were in attendance.

A. Meeting Opened

Mr. Sturgill called the meeting to order at 1:15 p. m. and the invocation was pronounced by Mr. Black. Following the call of the roll, the Secretary reported all members of the Executive Committee were present, and the meeting was declared officially open for the conduct of business at 1:17 p. m.

B. Minutes Approved

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, the reading of the Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees on June 22, 1976, was dispensed with and the Minutes were approved as published.

C. President's Report to the Trustees (PR 1)

Following a brief report by President Singletary of the events occurring on campus since the last meeting of the Board on June 22, 1976, PR 1 was accepted and ordered filed.

D. Recommendations of the President (PR 2)

President Singletary noted that PR 2 contained routine personnel changes and the quarterly report of gifts and/or grants, and recommended approval of PR 2 as a whole. Without discussion, on motion by Mr. Cooper, seconded by

Mr. Black and passed, PR 2 was approved as a whole and ordered made an official part of the Minutes of the meeting. (See PR 2 at the end of the Minutes.)

E. Budget Revisions for 1976-77 (PR 4)

President Singletary recommended that recommendations relative to revisions in the 1976-77 Budget as presented in PR 4 be authorized and approved. On motion by Mr. Black, seconded by Professor Sears, and passed, it was so ordered. (See PR 4 at the end of the Minutes.)

F. Creation of Position and Appointment of Associate Director-Biostatistics, Tobacco and Health Research Institute (PR 5)

President Singletary recommended the creation of the position of Associate Director-Biostatistics, Tobacco and Health Research Institute, and that Dr. Harlley McKean be appointed Associate Director-Biostatistics retroactive to July 1, 1976.

Mr. Black moved approval of the recommendation. His motion was seconded by Mr. Clay and passed without dissent. (See PR 5 at the end of the Minutes.)

G. Apartment Facility Named (PR 6)

After a brief explanation by Mr. Jack C. Blanton, on motion by Mr. Cooper, seconded by Mr. Griffin and passed, the name of Commonwealth Village was approved for the apartment facility owned by the University and located at 1435 South Limestone Street. (See PR 6 at the end of the Minutes.)

H. Change of Name of Department of Horticulture (PR 7)

President Singletary explained that the recommended change in the name of the Department of Horticulture to the Department of Horticulture and Landscape Architecture in the College of Agriculture came as a result of concern expressed for the identity of the program by a representative of the American Society of Landscape Architecture Advisors Committee on the Guidance of New Programs. President Singletary continued that the proposal to change the departmental name had the endorsement of the University Senate Council and recommended approval.

On motion by Mr. Clay, seconded by Mr. Black and passed, the name of the Department of Horticulture was changed to the Department of Horticulture and Landscape Architecture. (See PR 4 at the end of the Minutes.)

I. Interim Financial Report (FCR 1)

Mr. Clay, Chairman of the Committee, moved that the Interim Financial Report for the period ending May 31, 1976, be accepted. His motion was seconded by Mr. Cooper and passed without dissent. (See FCR1 at the end of the Minutes.)

J. Contract with Louisville and Jefferson County Board of Health, et al.(FCR 2)

Mr. Clay moved that the two recommendations in FCR 2 relative to the contract with the Louisville-Jefferson County Board of Health, et al., be approved. His motion was seconded by Mr. Griffin and passed. (See FCR 2 at the end of the Minutes.)

K. Quarterly Report on Investments (ICR 1)

Mr. Griffin moved that the quarterly report on changes made in investments for the University and its affiliated corporations for the quarter ending June 30, 1976, be accepted. His motion was seconded by Professor Sears and passed without dissent. (See ICR 1 at the end of the Minutes.)

L. Investment in the Common Fund

Mr. Griffin, Chairman of the Board's Investment Committee, reported that the Committee had met with the Investment Counsel from the First Kentucky Trust Company prior to the Executive Committee meeting and reviewed the handling of the University's endowment funds. Mr. Griffin reported that on the basis of "total return", earnings on endowment funds have been excellent.

In order to broaden the base of its investment advice and provide a benchmark for better gauging the performance of the First Kentucky Trust Company, Mr. Griffin reported that the Investment Committee had unanimously voted to place \$100,000 of endowment funds in the Common Fund, effective September 1, 1976. The Common Fund is a non-profit corporation which was formed in 1971 with the help of a \$2.5 million grant from the Ford Foundation to enable colleges, universities and independent schools to join together in obtaining professional management of their pooled endowments and other long-term investment funds.

M. Meeting Adjourned

There being no further business to come before the meeting, on motion duly made, seconded and carried, the meeting was declared adjourned at 1:35 p. m.

CREATION OF THE POSITION AND APPOINTMENT OF
AN ASSOCIATE DIRECTOR - BIostatISTICS,
TOBACCO AND HEALTH RESEARCH INSTITUTE

Recommendation: (1) that the position of Associate Director - Biostatistics, Tobacco and Health Research Institute be created; and (2) that Dr. Harlley McKean be appointed Associate Director - Biostatistics effective 1 July 1976.

Background: The research program of the Tobacco and Health Institute is directed toward the systematic explorations of the effects of the some 1500 chemical compounds in raw tobacco and over 5000 chemical compounds in solid, liquid and gaseous phases resulting from pyrolysis on biological systems. In such multivariate explorations the design of experiments and results therefrom can be undertaken and understood only in a statistical sense. For this reason the Tobacco and Health Research Institute has long had a strong capability in biostatistics. The recognition of the importance of strengthening biostatistics in the tobacco and health research area is emphasized by this recommendation.

Dr. Harlley McKean received the B.A. degree in 1952 from Cornell College in Iowa and the M.S. and Ph. D. degrees from Purdue University in 1954 and 1958 respectively. He then joined and remained on the faculty at Purdue until 1967, moving to the faculty of New Mexico State University, Los Cruces where he remained until 1971. In 1971 McKean became Professor of Statistics at the University of Kentucky, where he has been intimately involved in the research program of the Tobacco and Health Research Institute. Dr. McKean's services in the biostatistical and bioepidemiological areas have been of great value to other investigators on campus in the design of experiments and analysis. This appointment will further strengthen this important area.

CHANGE OF NAME OF DEPARTMENT OF HORTICULTURE

Recommendation: to change the name of the Department of Horticulture to the Department of Horticulture and Landscape Architecture in the College of Agriculture.

Background: In 1969-70 the Department of Horticulture began the development, in cooperation with the College of Architecture, of a baccalaureate degree program in Landscape Architecture. This new program was approved by the Council on Public Higher Education in 1974. During the past year, we were visited by a representative of the American Society of Landscape Architecture Advisors Committee on the Guidance of New Programs to obtain some assessment of our progress toward meeting accreditation standards at the earliest eligible time. One of the concerns expressed was for the identity of the program, and out of these considerations the above proposal was developed by the College of Agriculture. This proposal is also endorsed by the University Senate Council.

CONTRACT WITH LOUISVILLE AND JEFFERSON COUNTY
BOARD OF HEALTH, et al

Recommendation 1: that the Executive Committee authorize the Chairman and Secretary of the Board of Trustees to execute a Third Supplemental Contract permitting Jefferson County, Kentucky to borrow on behalf of the Louisville Medical Center, Inc., sums needed for the purpose of installing approximately 4,000 tons of additional chilled water equipment together with necessary sums for contingencies, engineering fees, capitalized interest, bond discounts and fiscal agent fees, at the steam and chilled water plant located in Louisville, Kentucky, and serving the Jefferson Community College together with several other institutions in the vicinity.

Recommendation 2: that such Chairman and Secretary be further authorized and directed to take such further action and to execute and deliver such further instruments, without limitation, as in the discretion of such Chairman and Secretary may from time to time be determined necessary or desirable to consummate their action as contemplated by such Third Supplemental Contract and the execution of such further instrument or instruments by such officers shall be conclusive evidence of the exercise of such discretion.

Background: This Board has previously authorized a contract dated as of May 1968, a first supplemental contract dated May 1972 and a second supplemental contract dated February 1, 1974, by and between this Board and Louisville and Jefferson County Board of Health, The County of Jefferson, Kentucky, The Jewish Hospital Association of Louisville, Kentucky, Norton-Children's Hospitals, Inc., Methodist-Evangelical Hospital, Inc., University of Louisville, Rehabilitation Center, Inc., and the Louisville Medical Center, Inc., whereby the aforementioned parties agreed that Jefferson County would issue revenue bonds to construct a steam and chilled water plant to serve the facilities operated by the parties. The debt service for such bonds is provided from charges made to the using agencies. This Third Supplemental Contract is for the purpose of expanding the chilled water services in contemplation of the new University of Louisville health

care facilities including the Institutional Services Building, the Ambulatory Care Building, and the Concentrated Care Building. Preliminary estimates indicate a probable cost of \$1,770,000.00.
