the Revolution, held on February 22nd. 1920, it was unanimously voted to denate to the Marne Momiment, intended as America's gift to France, the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00), to be raised by voluntary contributions, Ten dollars of the amount has already been contributed. The names of all contributors are to be recorded and placed under the corner-stone of the proposed momiment, the total cost of which will appreads a quarter of a million dollars.
