

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY ...

HISTORY AND GOVERNANCE

The University of Kenucky was founded in 1866 under the provisions of the Marrill Land-Grant Act. For the first 4by Jean, enrollment remained small, but by the turn of the century the University was becoming one of the most important institutions in the state.

UK took its present name in 1916 and at the same time assumed the reponsibility of being the state's principal institution for teaching, research and service. The University of Kentucky is governed by a 20 member Board of Trustees. Dr. Charles T. Wethington Jr. is the 10th President of the University.

THE CAMPUS

The University of Kentucky's 673-acre campus is located just south of downtown Lexington, Ky., which has a population of more than 230,000.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

The University of Kentucky has 17 academic colleges. They are: Arts and Sciences. Agriculture. Engineering. Business and Economics. Education. Human Brivton-mental Sciences. Library and Information Sciences. Social Work. Architecture. Communications. Fine Arts. Law. Medicine. Dentistry. Nursing. Allied Health Professions. "Pharmacy.

On the graduate level, 95 programs lead to the master's degree and \$91 to the doctorate in The Graduate School.

UK's full-time faculty numbers 1,643 on the Lexington campus and the Medical Center.

ADMISSIONS AND ENROLLMENT

TUITION AND FINANCIAL AID

The 1993-94 undergraduate tuition is \$1,139 per semester for residents of Kentucky and \$3099 for non-residents. Room

Enrollment on UK's Lexington campus totals about 24,000. Students are from every Kentucky county, from 49 other states and the District of Columbia and from 84 foreign countries. About 5,300 students live in UK's residence halls. About 2,700 UK students belong to fraternities and a large number of them live in the residences of these groups.

The University has about 115,000 alumni around the world with about 25,000 paid members in UK's National Alumni Association, including 8,883 life members. There are 61 active alumni clubs across the nation, with 32 of them in Kentucky and 26 outside the state from California to New York. There are four "young alumni" groups in Kentucky.

In athletics, UK has a total of 19 sports — 10 men's and 9 women's sports — competing on the highest level of national collegate competition.

COMMUNITY COLLEGES

The 14 community colleges in Kentucky are an importan part of the University of Kentucky. These two-year colleges located throughout the state, offer the first two years to the baccaliurareate program, associate technical degrees, and a wide variety of continuing education and community service programs. Enrollment at the community colleges statewide more than 48,000 students.


MEDICAL CENTER

UK's Chandler Medical Center has a wide range of programs in education and research. The five colleges -Medicinc, Dentistry, Nursing, Pharmacy and Allied Health Professions -- have more than 3.592 students pursuing bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees in health-related fields. Medical Center also has the 461-bed University of Kentucky Hospital as part of its teaching and service programs.
