Defeating terrorism, recession on Bush's agenda for new year

Address: 'My hope is that all nations will heed our call and eliminate the terrorist parasites'

In his first State of the union address to Congress and the nation Tuesday night, President Bush unveiled his plane to globe and pledge d a battle of equal vigor to revive the nation's alling economy.

"We will prevail in war, and we will defeat this recession." Bush said.

Bush, outlining his post-Afghanistan battle plans, stowed to unearth "a terrorist underworld" existing in a dozen countries, including the Philippines, Bosnia and Somalia. He said nations will be given a chance to wipe out terrorists themselves, and the Union States is willing to assist their efforts.

Bush addressed Americans with a tone of national unity not heard since Franklin D. Roosevelt. In polls, more than 80 percent of Americans say the property of the performance of the per

said Daniel Townsend, an art studio freshman.

In his address Bush asked lawmakers to back his education, trade and tax policies to promote jobs, and embrace his welfare, health care, farm and environmental initiatives.

Bush offered no exact details on these policies; the majority of the address focused on the war and the recession.

The U.S. must not stops short in its war on terrorism. Bush stressed. To do so would give the nation a sense of security that is both false and temporary, he explained.

"It is both our responsibility and our privilege to flight freedom's fight," Bush said.

Frankful County Circuit Judge William Graham left open a door for more tinkering with the boundaries and filing deadlines when he ordered that the Tuesday filing should be ignored until he orders otherwise. Legislators pondered setting a midnight deadline truesday in a bill they could pass late in the evening, but that would have run the risk of further irritating Graham. Legislators, though, favor a quick filing deadline to avoid any new opposition.


Officials say plant explosion contained

Officials say plant explosion contained CALVERT CITY, Ky. — Emergency officials said a fire and chemical release at a western Kentucky chemical company Tuesday afternoon was contained and won't pose a threat to the nearby community. "The chemicals have been confined to the general area of the plant," said Ray Bowman, director of the state Office of Emergency Management. "There don't appear to be any ill effects." Bowman said that a fire at the plant burned up most of the chemicals and the rest dissipated. No one was injured in the explosion, which ignited around 1230 p.m. CST and burned until 3:30 p.m., officials said. Bowman said Westlake's own onsite fire-suppression unit put out the fire.

Student's family sues after suicide

QUINCY, Mass. — Elizabeth Shin had tried
to kill herself with pills and later by cutting her
arms and wrists. Two years ago, she succeeded,
setting herself on fire at one of the nation's best
universities. Her parents claim the Massachusetts Institute of Technology failed to properly
deal with obvious signs of Shin's mental illness
and filed a §27 million lawauit Monday accusing
the school of negligence. The school has denied
any wrongdoing, Shin, 19, a biology major from
Livingston, N.J., died in April 2000. She had received treatment through MIT's counselling and
support services for more than a year before her
death, and had repeatedly threatened to commit
suicide.

Chokshi, 20, a junior at Duke University and
chairman of the student-run honor council.

Mother sentenced for closeting child

Mother sentenced for closeting child DALLAS — A woman was sentenced Tuesday to life in prison for confining her severely mainourished 8-year-old daughter in a flithy closet. Barbara Atkinson was arrested last June after the girl, who weighed 25 pounds, was discovered near death. 'She laid there naked in her own feces, in her own urine, praying someone might open the door,' said prosecutor Susan Hawk, asking jurors to hand down a life sentence. Defense attorneys said the defendant suffered a traumatic childhood. He said that during the first three years of Atkinson's life, she was neglected by her birth mother, a prostitute and drug addict.





UK should not pay for inconvenience

While UK should offer more times, sections of needed classes, the burden should fall on students to ensure they graduate

We've all had times when a class we wanted or needed to take was closed or canceled. Occasionally, this leads to a senior having to stay in school for an extra semester to finish their degree. This leads to more time spent here and further financial

Tony Stoeppel, a student government senator, said he has the answer to this problem. He proposed graduation contracts, which would require UK to pay the extra tition should students have to stay beyond four years because of the unavailability

While it is clearly a major inconvenience to spend more time in college than intended, providing a subsidy to inconvenienced students is not the answer. It is not UK's responsibility to provide free tuition to students who need another semester to

The university does deserve some of the blame, though. A simple glance at the spring schedule shows how many classes are limited to one or two sections. Whether this is the result of a lack of faculty or a lack of classroom space, something needs to

be done.

But the answer in the short run is not money. UK should spend more time educating incoming freshmen on exactly what classes they need in order to graduate in four years. Some departments have taken the initiative and offer a checklist of major requirements on the Internet. This option should be made universal.

Another idea is to limit the number of honors students that are allowed to enroll in classes other students need to graduate. Since honors students schedule first, regular students are often unable to take these classes.

A large part of scheduling conflicts is personal responsibility. If you absolutely

A large part of scheduling conflicts is personal responsibility. If you absolutely have to take a class only offered at 8 a.m., take it. It is not UK's fault that some students

nave to take a class only offered at a kin, take it. It is not OK staut that some students simply don't want to wake up early.

UK and students alike need to take steps to improve the 17 percent four-year graduation rate. That number is ridiculously low, and should not be acceptable at a university longing to claim the mantle of academic excellence. And the answer lies in educating incoming students in scheduling, not in paying extra tuition.


