

255. (MONTHLY BILLS), 1937--. In (Health Records), entry 275. Itemized receipted monthly bills for medical supplies, showing date purchased, amount, total paid for month, and date paid.

259. (HISTORY RECORDS, MIDWIVES), 1927--. In (Health Records), entry 275. Midwife record, showing date, name of midwife, age, color, address, equipment, intelligence and character, cleanliness, education, health, laboratory findings, live births, certificates received, date, deliveries, notes on field conference visits, maternal deaths, date and cause.

260. (MONTHLY REPORTS), 1938--. In (Health Records), entry 275. Duplicate copies of health officer's monthly report to state board of health, showing county, or district, population of health jurisdiction, period, year, services, communicable disease control, consultations with physicians, field visits, itemized list of number and kind of communicable diseases, approved by state and territorial health officers, United States Public Health Service, and United States Children's Bureau.

261. (QUARTERLY REPORTS, NARRATIVES), 1927--. In (Health Records), entry 275. Copies of narrative reports to state board of health, showing summary of work accomplished by health officer for quarter, date of report, name of county health officer.
