The faculty met in President's room in the college building at 4 pm.

Present: President Patterson, Profs. White, W.K. Patterson, Roark, Tignor, Peuce, Anderson, Kastle Mathews, Miller, Wernicke, and Brooks.

The minutes of the preceding meeting were read and approved.

Prof. White reported class honors for the current year as follows: Messers, L.R. Ryan, L.H. Frankel, and A.V. Lester, as honor students in the Classical, Mechanical Engineering and Civil Engineering Courses, respectively. That Miss Julia Cox had been selected to represent the young ladies, and J.E. Heston to represent the Scientific Course. That Mr. Ryan is to have the last place on the programme and to deliver an oration of ten minutes and a farewell of one minute.

*Case of Discipline* Cadet J.W. Smedley, charged with repeated non attendance at Squad came before the faculty to request a re-consideration of the action of the Board of Discipline by which he was ~~suspended~~ suspended from college.

Voted on motion of Prof. Miller seconded by Prof. Mathews that the application of cadet Smedley be referred back to the same Board of Discipline which tried <sup>him</sup> and that said Board reconsider and retry the case.

Prof. Patterson moved that the Board of Discipline be composed of the ~~Commandant~~ and four other members of the faculty and that each Board serve two months.

Prof. Peuce moved to amend by providing that there shall be three Boards during the year - one for each term.

 Prof. Anderson moved that Standing Committee  
 of five members of the Faculty be appointed  
 for each term of the Collegiate year, and  
 that all matters of discipline not of a  
 military nature shall come before this Committee.

After some discussion the whole matter  
 was laid on the table.

On motion of Prof. Kastle ordered that Prof.  
 White be requested to make out the examination  
 schedule and announce the same as soon as  
 possible.

On motion of Prof. Matthews ordered that  
 "it is the sense of the Faculty that the  
 Battalion return from Chattanooga by the  
 evening of Saturday the 12th instant"

On a rising vote the ayes were 6, no's 5.

On motion the faculty adjourned to  
 meet at 3 pm on Friday May the 11th.
