AMENDMENTS TO BY-LAWS

(Adopted January 2, 1934)

ATTACH TO POLICY

Section III.

(b) Meetings:—The annual meeting of the Association shall be held on the second Tuesday in January at ten o'clock, A. M. each year, in the city of Noblesville, Indiana. Special meetings of the Association shall be called whenever the Board of Directors or Executive Committee shall so order.

Section VIII.

Reduction and Cancellation of Insurance

(a) That any item or items insured under this policy may be reduced in amount or amounts upon the written request of the insured; and or by the Association, by giving five days written notice of such reduction.

(b) This policy shall be cancelled at any time at the request of the insured, by paying all just claims and dues or pending assessments and returning his policy to the Secretary; or by the Association, by giving five days written notice of such cancellation.

Section IX.

(a) Policy Fee and Assessments:—A policy fee and assessment to be fixed by the Board of Directors shall be paid by the applicant at the time of making application for insurance.

(b) Assessments:—The Board of Directors shall make such assessments on the policy holders, based on the amount insured and the class of property covered, as may be necessary for losses and expenses. The Secretary shall by letter directed to the last given postoffice address, notify each member of the amount due from him.

(c) Assessments:—If any member refuses, neglects or fails to pay his assessment or assessments within thirty days from the date of such notice, then his policy shall be absolutely null and void without further notice.

(d) Reinstatement:—Whenever any policy shall have become null and void by reason of nonpayment of assessment or assessments, said policy may be reinstated upon the written request of the insured and the payment in full of all unpaid assessments.

Received of G. H. Palmer ^{\$}40.⁰⁰, which is payment in full for six (6) months use of a driveway through Mr. Ballard's farm to Stahl timber. Driveway to be used until all of timber and wood is cut and hauled from Stahl woods. Temporary gates to be built by Mr. Palmer. after hauling is finished, fences, where temporary gates have been, are to be put in same condition that are in at this time, by Mr. Palmer. In case Mr. Palmer sees fit to use drive-way longer than six months, Mr. Ballard is to receive \$6.67 per month until all timber and wood is hauled. This contract goes into effect Sept. 1, 1922.

This drive-way is to be 16 feet
in width.
