

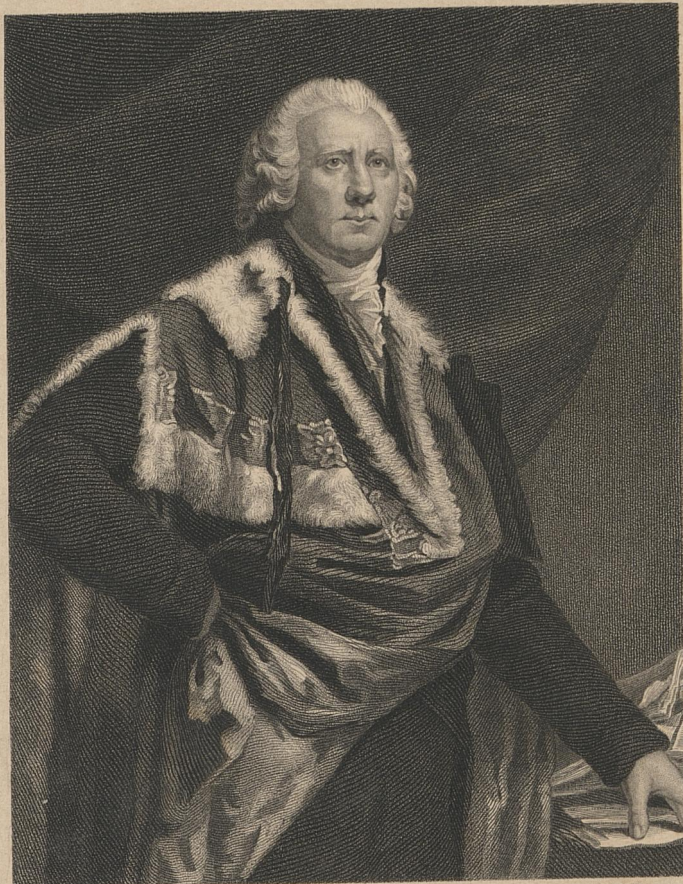
Turin. 16th Febr.
