The Debt, tho' due under a pawl Lease only, is to be consid<sup>d</sup> in the  
Administration of the Assets as equal to specialty Debts, and may be  
retained by the Administrator, ag<sup>t</sup> specialty Creditors. But the Demand in  
Debt of the Debt in the Issue, not being a liquidated Demand, but only  
made in Demerit cannot be retained.
