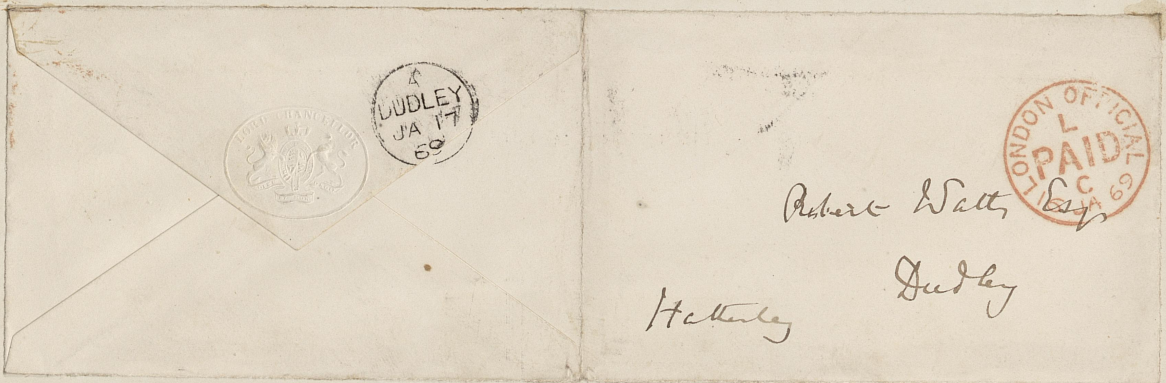

WHITEHALL, DEC. 10.—The Queen has been pleased by letters patent under the Great Seal to grant the dignity of a Baron of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland unto the Right Hon. Sir William Page Wood, Knight, Chancellor of that part of the said United Kingdom called Great Britain, and to the heirs male of his body lawfully begotten, by the name, style, and title of Baron Hatherley, of Down Hatherley, in the county of Gloucester.
