- busy to be in so long
neglect to thank you for the
kind of your book & the honor

employed by the Government who be-
trayed them - The delegate to
Paris was my father's friend

J. Watt & son of the celebrated Watt
who died at Aston Hall two
or three years ago - This was

markable because Mr. Watt was
also regarded in the discussion of
the subject as one of the principal persons
in Manchester & the utility of
1795 repeated mentioned in Datt
as the only person the Government had
ever been able to arrest.
