Middle Temple, 1874; successively Law Lecturer, Tutor. and Student, Christ Church, Fellow of Oriel College; Delegate of Clarendon Press, Oxford. *Publications*: editor of English History from Contemporary Writers; Early England up to the Norman Conquest (Epochs of English History); Alfred the Great and William the Conqueror; Old Stories from British History; History of England to 1509; co-editor with the late G.
