VAILLANT, Jean Baptiste Philibert, Comte de, French military commander, b. at Dijon, Dec. 6, 1790; studied at the École Polytechnique of Paris and Metz, and entered the army as lieutenant, 1809; taken prisoner in the Russian campaign, 1813; took part in the battle of Waterloo; captain, 1816; colonel, 1833; governor of the École Polytechnique, 1839, and director of the fortifications of Paris, 1840; lieutenant-general, 1845; marshal of France, 1851; received the title of count, 1852; minister of war, 1854-60; governor of the Prince Imperial, 1860; minister of the Imperial House, Nov. 14, 1861.
