Gough, John Bartholomew (b. 1817, d. 1886), temperance orator; was born in Kent, but in 1829 emigrated to America. After a life of intemperance, he, in 1842, became a total abstainer, and from that time devoted himself to the temperance cause as an orator, visiting England several times, and carrying on his campaign also in the States and the colonies. His Autobiography was published in 1879, and further personal sketches called Sunlight and Shadow in 1881, and an edition of his speeches was also brought out.
