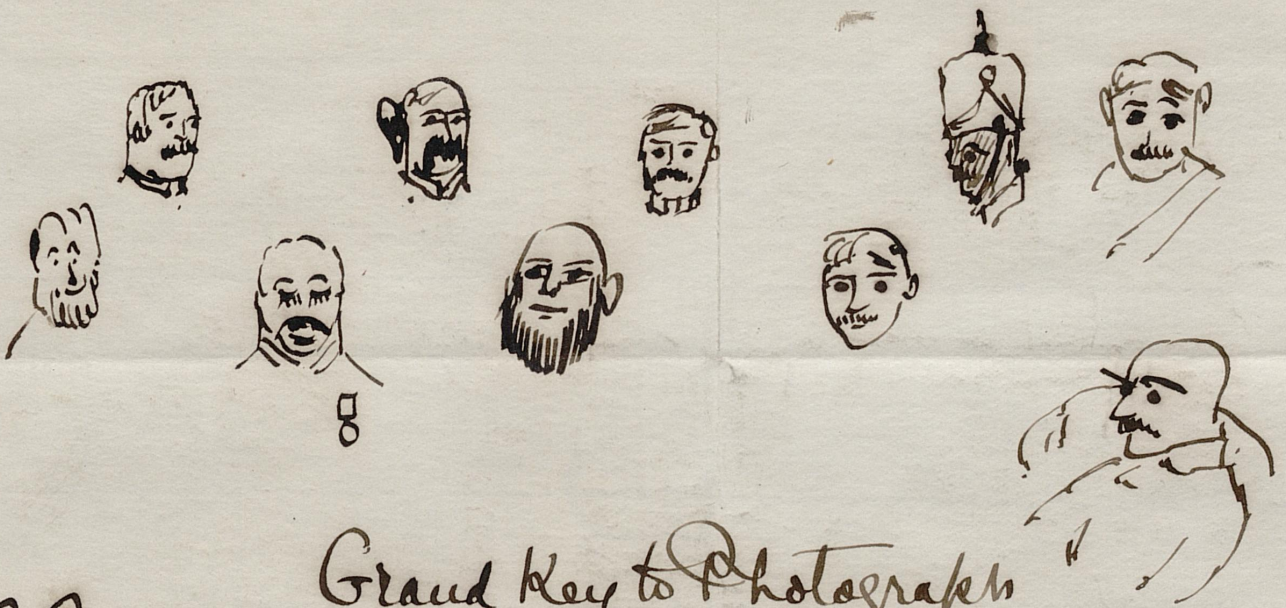




BUCKINGHAM AND CHANDOS, Richard Plantagenet Campbell, Duke of, English statesman, b. 1823, only son of the second Duke of Buckingham; educated at Eton, and Christ Church, Oxford; sat as M.P. for Buckingham, 1846-57; keeper of the privy seal to the Prince of Wales, 1852; chairman of the London and North-Western Railway Company, 1853-61; succeeded to the dukedom, July, 1861; lord president of the council, July 6, 1866, to March 6, 1867; appointed secretary of state for the colonies, March 6, 1867.
