
My Pience Bonnet for the Collection of a. Corper Engrange

Bone, Henry, an eminent artist, celebrated for his skill in enamel painting, was born at Truro, in 1755. On coming to London, he was for many years engaged in painting devices in enamel for jewellery; but he subsequently attained the highest excellence as a miniature portrait painter on ivory and in enamel. Continuing to rise in public esti-mation, Bone carried his art to the utmost perfection, increasing the size of his plates beyond anything which had before been attempted, and executing in enamel several copies of pictures by the first masters; one of which, Titian's 'Bacchus and Ariadne,' he painted on a plate 18 inches by 16, and sold it for 2200 guineas. Among his most munificent patrons was the duke of Bedford, for whom he executed a series of portraits of the Russell family from the reign of Henry VIII. He also executed eighty-five portraits of the great men of the Elizabethan period, and a series of the royalists of the civil war. He was chosen A.R.A. in 1801, R.A. ten years later, and held the appointment of enamel-painter to George III., George IV., and William IV. He closed a long life of persevering industry and integrity in 189,138,4 December, 1834.
