

Ernest Augustus, King of Hanover and Duke of Cumberland (*b.* 1771, *d.* 1851), fifth son of George III. ; entered the English army, and rose to the rank of field-marshall ; in 1815 married the Princess Frederica of Mecklenburg-Strelitz ; succeeded to the crown of Hanover in 1837. *194, 16R, 2*
