SIR ARCHIBALD NAPIER, Knt., who having accompanied James VI. into England, was sworn of the privy council, appointed treasurer-depute of Scotland, in 1622; appointed clerk and a judge of Session, in 1623; created a Baronet of Nova Scotia, 2 March, 1627; and elevated to the peerage of Scotland, 4 May, in the same year, as Baron Napier, of Merchistoun. He m. Margaret, dau. of John, 4th Earl of Montrose, and dying in 1645, left, with two daus. (Margaret, m. to Sir George Stirling, of Keir; and Lilias, who d. unm.),
