Sir Andrew, who was for more than fifty years, in the diplomatic service, was Minister in Switzerland, 1852; envoy at Copenhagen, 1853; Madrid, 1858; and at the Hague, 1860; ambassador to Prussia, 1862; to Russia, 1864; and to Austria, 1871. He retired 1877. He was made K.C.B. 1860, and G.C.B. 1866; sworn a privy councillor 1863; and created a Baronet, 14 Dec. 1878. He d. 13 Nov. 1882.
